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
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


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
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The Catholic Church was the dominant religion in Europe

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
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
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


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Some monarchs used exploration to gain colonies and to increase their wealth & power



Absolute monarchs believed in divine right, the idea that God created the monarchy & kings answered only to God, not the people

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

By 1600, some European kings had become absolute monarchs Absolute monarchy is a government in which one king should hold all the power within a country
